Resolution 1 of 2026 Authorization for Coal Dock Park Shoreline Stabilization Application -

Larrea noted that this is the second of a possible three grants the Village will be seeking for shoreline stabilization on the Coal Dock. Larrea stated that the Village will be offsetting some cost in kind for employee time. Perkins asked if any trees would be removed. Larrea stated that in the location of the stabilization there are no trees that would be disturbed.

Bahle moved Christensen seconded, CARRIED to adopt Resolution 1 of 2026 authorizing the application for the Coal Dock Park Shoreline Stabilization grant hereby making a financial commitment in the amount of \$17,436.31 with \$11,700 in cash, \$5,736.31 in kind.
