**Compost Site** will be open thru April 3rd through September 25th on Friday mornings by appointment only. For arrangements, contact the Department of Public Works at 271-1032.

**Hydrant Flushing:** Most flushing will take place at night between 10:00 p.m. and 5:00 a.m. with limited day flushing between 7:30 a.m. to 3:00 p.m. While flushing doesn't affect the safety of the water supply, tap water may appear cloudy or discolored immediately after flushing. If discoloration is present, run your cold water in the bathtub or utility sink until clear. Avoid using washing machines the day of flushing and for 24 hours after, since clothing could become discolored. Contact the Department of Public Works, 271-1032, with questions.

**Chlorination** of the water system begins two days before flushing starts and continues until flushing is complete. A small amount of chlorine is added to the water system only during this time as a preventative measure against bacterial

contamination.

**Brush and Leaf Pick-up: Brush and Yard Waste Bio-bag Pick-up** in the Spring and Fall, on the dates indicated. Place brush and leaves curb side by Monday morning. Please separate brush from leaves and limit brush length to six feet. During the summer months of June, July and August, yard waste must be contained in a bio-degradable bag used for this purpose and placed curb side by 8:00 a.m. on Thursday morning. Brush must be separate from yard waste with limbs no larger than 6" wide and 6' long, placed at the curb.

Spring Clean Up/Curbside Pick-up will occur September 14, 2020. Please have all refuse to the curbside by 7:00 am Monday morning. American Waste will make one pass down each street. Accepted: No more than 15 bags or equivalent, one large white appliance freon fee, two tires. NOT ACCEPTED: liquids, chemicals, hazardous substances, batteries or mattresses.
