PURPOSE

To adopt the attached resolution.

OVERVIEW

Following the submittal of a grant to the Michigan Department of Natural Resources (Waterways Division) the Village received notice that our request to construct a Public Building & Boater Services Project (WW24-0008) was selected for funding.

The Village is essentially accepting the \$406,016 in State funding and agreeing to match that \$406,016 to reach the estimated project total of \$812,032. The project match will be funded mostly by the Marina Fund and DDA. The DDA's portion is estimated to be approximately 50% of the required match.

The attached Resolution 2024-06 is an extension of the agreement and therefore required to be passed (roll call vote) to formerly accept the terms of the grant and execute the agreement.

WHEREAS, pro-active mitigation of known hazards before a disaster event can reduce or eliminate damages and impacts to life, property, the environment or local economy; and

WHEREAS, The Disaster Mitigation Act (DMA) of 2000 (Public Law 106-390) established new requirements for pre- and post-disaster hazard mitigation programs; and

WHEREAS, the 2023 Leelanau County Natural Hazard Mitigation Plan 5 Year Update has been developed in accordance to the DMA of 2000 to reflect the concerns of the citizens and stakeholders of Leelanau County; and

WHEREAS, the Village of Suttons Bay previously adopted the 2016 Leelanau County Natural Hazard Mitigation Plan on July 20, 2015 by Resolution Number 6 of 2015; and

WHEREAS, the Village of Suttons Bay affirmed participation in the maintenance of the 2023 Leelanau County Natural Hazard Mitigation Plan and committed to participating in the update of the Plan no less than once every 5 years; and

WHEREAS, the 2023 Leelanau County Natural Hazard Mitigation Plan provides a set of actions to reduce risk from natural hazards through education and outreach programs, establishes a foundation for coordination among agencies in Leelanau County, identifies future mitigation projects, and meets the qualifications for federal assistance programs in order to be eligible for FEMA pre-disaster and post-disaster mitigation grant funding;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that Village of Suttons Bay Council does hereby adopt the 2023 Leelanau County Natural Hazard Mitigation Plan 5 Year Update as an official plan of the Village of Suttons Bay.
