

COMMITTEE OF THE WHOLE MEETING NOTES OF SEPTEMBER 9, 2025 @ 8:30 am

The meeting was called to order at 8:30 a.m. by Christensen. Present: Bahle, Christensen, Lutke, Suppes, & Smith

Reports: Miller stated S. Shore has been resurfaced and striped. Getting equipment ready for winter and will be doing hydrant flushing next month.

Marina Report: Season is winding down. Edie stated that the summer was slower than previous years.

Committee Member Information: Smith stated she is concerned about speeding on South Shore Drive.

Public Comment: Kim Eike, talked about the speed on S. Shore. He stated he bikes and walks on S. Shore and would like to see some traffic calming measures.

New Business:

A. VSB-2025-26 Boater Service & Public Restrooms Update

Manager Larrea stated that they have received some cost estimates from Abonmarche and they are higher than originally estimated. Rob presented two options. The second option would eliminate the roof overhang, the architectural structure on the roof and eliminate a stall and a sink in the men's and woman's bathroom. Committee members unanimously agreed they would like to keep Option 1. Manager Larrea stated the next step would be to bid it out and hope for a Spring start.

B. St Marys Street Discussion.

Deputy Neumann was present and stated after speaking with staff and residents he understands there is speeding on Elm Street, St Marys Street and S. Shore Drive. Council members discussed what they have seen as well. Concerns ranged from running stop signs to visibility at the corners. Council also noted that with the visibility of Deputy Neumann, we should begin to see his presence as a traffic calming measure. Council did not feel a speed/traffic study was necessary.

Council suggested a newsletter be sent out talking about traffic speeds and monitoring areas for speeding. Deputy Neumann stated that enforcement itself is education.
