

COMMITTEE OF THE WHOLE MEETING NOTES OF OCTOBER 13, 2021

The meeting was called to order at 8:10 a.m.

Reports

DPW Director Miller stated the focus is on Utility infrastructure. The Vactor truck is out today jetting and cleaning sewers. Water chlorination and hydrant flushing was completed last week. Curbside leaf pickup begins next week. The department will be transitioning into lift station winterization. Crosswalk signs were removed for the Suttons Bay School parade and have been stored for the winter. Miller further stated the WWTP is transitioning to the colder weather.

Harbor Master Aylsworth states she is proposing an increase in Marina fees for the 2022 season. An application for rip rap at the North Pier has been submitted to EGLE and the permit could be here next week. Elmer's can then begin taking about six weeks to complete. Winterizing has begun at the Marina. Buoys will be pulled today. The Marina closes to the public on Friday and the end of the month for the seasonal slip holders. Aylsworth states an increase in transient boaters, noting larger boats and people living on their boats, and anticipates the same for next year.

Caution against two many goals; better to break it down to reach achievement Projects mean financial commitment
