

As you may have noticed recently, the Village of Suttons Bay had to have guardrails installed on Elm St over the southernmost culvert near Herman rd. The bridge abutment was broken off and partially submerged in Leo Creek from a traffic accident. After a site assessment, the damage was too extensive for any safe and lasting repair.

Our DPW team removed the large broken structure from the creek and coordinated with local agencies regarding the work that took place. It was ultimately decided to guardrail both sides of the street to protect the other existing abutment. This is a short-term measure as we continue to explore improvements to this area.
