Reports

DPW Director Report

The DPW Director report was submitted by Miller and can be found in this meeting packet. In addition, asphalt work has been completed around the Village.

VSB – 2024-02 Stratton Way Petition

Committee questioned whether a problem truly exists noting however that Stratton Way is not very functional. Deputy Donohue stated no complaints or accidents have ever been reported to his knowledge. A traffic study would be necessary if Council wanted to consider the request further. The request, if granted, would require substantial signage. Committee stated that it does not feel like a logical traffic flow and could cause additional problems if it became a one-way. Committee does not believe there is a valid reason to change to a one way. It was the consensus of Committee to recommend to Council to not change Stratton Way to a one-way street.

Status Update – Other Committees

VSB-2024-03 Marina Slip Request

Larrea stated the Marina Committee considered a request to transfer a slip, and following discussion, it was the consensus to support the Harbor Master's decision to not transfer the license because it is not allowed in the ordinance.

VSB-2024-04 Marina Master Plan

Larrea stated the Marina Master Plan draft could be ready for approval in March. It is basically an update focusing on what the Village would like to accomplish in the next

five years. A company was hired to update the plan, noting Northport's success with receiving grants after this company rewrote their Marina Master Plan.
