REMOTE MEETING NOTES OF APRIL 6, 2021

The meeting was called to order at 8:10 a.m., by Lutke.

Reports

The General Service-Utility/Marina report was submitted by DPW Director Miller and can be found in this meeting packet. Miller reviewed his report with Committee.

Report VSB-2021-18 Park Signs

It was the consensus of Committee to allow the Administrative and Utility/Marina Committee to also have input into the proposed Park signs. Pending their input, it was suggested to obtain another option or two and perhaps allow public comment on the proposed park signs.

Committee member comments

Larrea stated that he is still trying to close out the TAP grant project. Larrea will be attending court on Friday for the damage done to the bridge and culvert on Elm Street hit by a car. Larrea asked Committee members if they wanted to go back to in-person meetings or if they wanted to continue virtual Zoom meetings by declaring a local state of emergency. It was the consensus of Committee to recommend Council continue virtual Zoom meetings for another 3 or 4 months at which time it will be reviewed again. Pending input from the other Committee meetings this week, a special meeting would be scheduled for next Monday to declare the local state of emergency which would allow the continuance of virtual Zoom meetings.

Lutke asked on behalf of his son if and when repairs are done on sidewalks, to consider the sidewalk on Lincoln and West. Larrea stated that dollars are currently being set aside for sidewalk repairs.

Public Comments

Bill Perkins inquired about the following:

Is Sutton Park also known as South Park? Yes.

He suggested placing Welcome signs at both ends of the Village with space enough to promote special events.

Define banners. Banners are placed on the new light poles. Banners are no longer permitted across M-22 because those poles have been removed.

Do the cameras used to view the water and sewer pipes tell where the cracks are? Yes, and when possible, the repairs will be done inside the pipes with a bonding material.
