Subject:	Stratton Way Petition		

**PURPOSE**

To discuss Stratton Way vehicular travel options.

**OVERVIEW**

A petition from residents of Stratton Way began the discussion of changing the road to a one-way travel way. That petition has since been modified, however, following several meetings and discussions the intent of the petition remains the same. Residents of Stratton Way have concerns with the narrowness of the street and with the speed of traffic entering the street from M-204.


**STAFF COMMENT**

The Village Council requested Staff to continue to work towards a solution to alleviate the safety concerns on Stratton Way. In doing so, there appears to be four options for the committee to consider. Should the committee favor a particular option, a recommendation for further discussion at the April 15<sup>th</sup> Village Council meeting would be appropriate.

1. The Village could budget for the expansion of the roadbed to 20 feet, maximizing the ROW and leaving vehicular travel as it is. This is the costliest option with the highest probability of compounding the concerns.
2. Create a one-way travel way from Concord towards M-204. This is likely to be the most problematic and has the highest probability of failing due to human nature. To continue this option, I believe a "Traffic Control Order" (TCO) would be required by the State Police.
3. Place "Do Not Enter" signs at M-204 preventing vehicles from entering Stratton Way. Like number 2 above, this option would require a TCO performed by the State Police.
4. Place "No Thru Traffic" signs on M-204. This appears to be the quickest and most affordable "first step" type of solution. This option does not require an immediate TCO, and would allow for further observation prior to having to implement #3 above.
