2022 Goals and Objectives Work Session

- Continue to increase the value in the Village to bring in more visitors, noting park improvements.
- Streets
 - o Streamline services
 - o Add a shoulder to S. Shore Drive
- Sidewalks
 - o Repair and maintenance, improve pedestrian walk ways
- Parks
 - o Continue enhancing/improving the parks
 - Sutton Park
 - Add a playground system
 - Concrete walk
 - Center feature with benches and pavers
- Parking lots
 - o Address and improve the parking lot in front of the Insight Optometry. Gravel for now with an opportunity for a public/private partnership in the future.

Larrea stated a template of the Village logo has been created and will be used for places like Village buildings, sidewalks, etc.

Public comments

Bill Perkins states a possible six-month extension to the now, Herman Road recycling center, further stating a temporary site should be explored on Village Park property. Perkins states recycling should be added to the zoning ordinance. Committee requested a formalized proposal, with specifics, be brought forth to further the discussion.

Karin Andrews, 345 S. Shore Drive, supported adding shoulders to S. Shore Drive, as well as supports the Sutton Park discussion. Andrews states the Village Hall is the best waterfront property and would like to see visitors' information provided there.
