

PLANNING COMMISSION MEETING <u>NOTES</u> OF JANUARY 13, 2021

The meeting was called to order at 5:02 p.m.

Public Comment

Lois Bahle stated Leelanau County Solid Waste Council has received a grant to conduct a study on the County's recycling sites, and suggests Deuster Park and the DPW building as possible sites for recycling bins.

Bill Perkins noted a lot of recreational use on the sledding hill at Bahle's. He suggested mowing the upper part of the old ski hill and that the Village should explore reopening he ski hill. He furthered suggested looking at the Village's insurance policy as it relates to the ski hill, and perhaps open the lifts up again.

Reports

Zoning Administrator Report – Couturier reported there is not a lot of permitting right now, and that she is working on an enforcement issue on the north end of the Village.

Manager's Report – Larrea stated he has been closing up last year's projects, namely the Marina project, and is working on closing up the TAP project. Larrea visited the parks today getting ready for the 2021 season, noting \$30,000 in the budget for maintenance and improvements.

Village Council updates – Suppes stated Council has appointed Debra Smith as Village Council Trustee to fill the vacancy.

Good of the Order

Hylwa asked about the water issue on the trail behind the library. Larrea will look into the history of the water issue.

Ostrowski stated he believes it would be a huge expense to reopen the ski hill due to safety regulations.

Danielson stated that reopening the ski hill is an interesting concept, and suggests leasing the hill to a private organization or a non-profit to manage the ski hill.
