SUTTONS PARK EVENT

The Swim for Grand Traverse Bay event is an annual fundraiser to help raise money for the Watershed Center. This annual race typically occurs in or around Traverse City, however, this year it will be held at Sutton Park on Saturday, August 9, 2025. All funds raised with this event will go towards protecting our clean waters and nearly 1,000 square miles of watershed.

GRANT UPDATES

Over the next few weeks, you should see an abundance of new wildflowers sprouting along the creek, several new trees being planted along the perimeter of the park and various other improvements taking place as we implement phase two of this exciting restoration project.

STREET SWEEPING

The Village is scheduled for the streets to be swept beginning Monday April 14th, 2025. Residents should not park on the street, nor place leaves and debris in the street during this time. Sweeping usually starts first thing in the morning and takes a week to finish.

WATER CHLORINATION

The Water Department will begin routine maintenance of our water system on Saturday April 19th. This process typically lasts 1-week during which time you may notice a slight discoloration in your water.
